

Blundell's School Archive Copyright Policy

Image Reproduction Fees

- i. Reproduction fees vary depending on how the images will be used. Publication of images of the documents themselves falls within the scope of Tradable Information, for which the payment of reproduction fees applies under contract law.
- ii. The School waives this fee for academic and non-profit publications, but where possible we request a complimentary copy of the book or article.
- iii. For other publications, a reproduction fee will be charged for any images. This will depend on the print run requested. £50 is the standard base rate, but for a print run of over 100,000 this will rise to £100.
- iv. Electronic rights are automatically included with fees for print (if applicable – see points ii. and iii.). For example, the prices for book publishing include e-book rights.
- v. In all cases, copyright needs to be acknowledged and attributed to Blundell's School.
- vi. If requesting images remotely a standard imaging fee of £15 will be charged. UK customers will be charged VAT on reproduction fees.
- vii. No fee is payable for photographs taken in person if required for personal use, research or study – only the above imaging fee to be charged if applicable.
