Tour HQ, programme and accommodation

Tour headquarters will be at the home of Chad & Sharon Murrin at 1 Old Kiln Barn, Berry Lane, Worplesdon, Guildford GU3 3QF. This is between Guildford and Woking. The games at Woking, Horsely and Guildford are all within 15 minutes.

Chad & Sharon will be hosting lunch at their home on Wednesday 13 August.

Tourists are asked to make their own arrangements to travel to Woking & Horsell CC 12.30 pm on the Tuesday for the afternoon game.

Accommodation (six x twin rooms) has been booked in the Acacia Villas Guest House at 29 Woodbridge Road, Guildford GU1 1ED. This is located across the road from Guildford CC and a short walk from the town centre. Secure overnight parking will be available at Guildford CC. Rooms have been booked for three nights. Players will be expected to share a room.

If we need additional accommodation or if you are bringing your wife or partner and would like a double room, we will make separate arrangements. Please let us know. If you prefer to make individual arrangements for accommodation, this is fine.

Costs

The OBCC will underwrite and significantly subsidise the costs from Club funds. These costs include match fees and cricket expenses, meals and accommodation.

Tourists will each make a contribution of £75 per head (£50 for those aged under-25) and meet their own travel expenses and beer kitty.
